1. The consultation phase.

So that you know, which chances and risks your idea has, we advise you regarding it

- Assessment of your professional background.
- Analysis and assessment of the business idea.
- Rough estimate of your chances in the market.
- What are the external conditions?
- What are the individual living conditions?
- Which professional qualifications are fulfilled?

2. The implementation phase.

It becomes concrete. Now that we have clarified the different needs and requirements, it now says:

- Support in the development of the business concept.
- What funding opportunities are available through the employment agency (Gründungszuschuss) or the jobcenter (Einstiegsgeld)?
- obtaining debt, for example by the BAB, "The development bank for Bremen and Bremerhaven".
- Support in cooperation with the STARTHAUS Bremerhaven and Bremen.
- Participation in specific afz seminars such as: business basics, marketing.
